Program Notes

Music for Piano and Orchestra was conceived from a single melodic fragment – the opening gesture in the piano. From there, the piece grew almost on its own, taking form and evolution with every session in front of my laptop screen. I took inspiration from one of my favorite examples of orchestration and approach, Igor Stravinsky, but not at the expense of my own voice. In these three movements, I explain a single motivic idea and its many permutations, allowing for the idea to grow organically as well as technically. The piece is my voice, my energy and my style all infused with the orchestration techniques of Stravinsky that I admire so dearly – I feel that this work embodies a high level of artistry without sparing anything on paper or in effect. I am proud of this work and I hear this as one of my truest expressions of myself as an artist.
